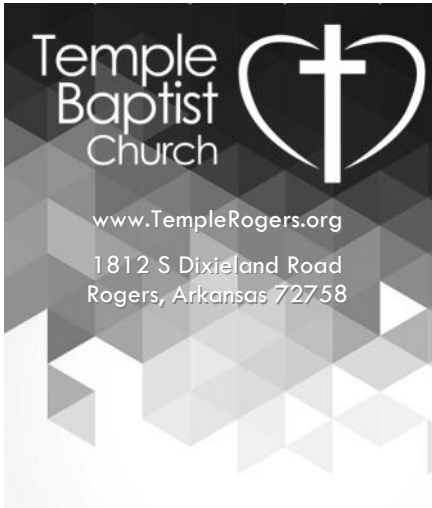

We're so glad that you are here to worship with us today. If this is your first time to be our guest, we want to thank you for checking us out. It is our privilege to host you today, and it is our prayer that you will be blessed as a result of your visit!

Over the past month or so, we've been going through a series of studies focused on the first statement of our Mission Statement—Connect People to God. I want to commend you all for listening to my encouragement in this area and responding with action! It was wonderful to have so many guests in our services last week! I want to again encourage you to continue inviting your family, friends, co-workers and acquaintances to join you in worship each Sunday. Remember, 85% of people say that it was a personal invitation from a friend or family member that brought them to church.

Today, we will begin a new series that will focus on the second statement in our Mission Statement—Unite People to One Another. That phrase—"One Another"—is found 100 times in 94 verses in the New Testament. About one-third of these deal with how the church ought to get along. Another one-third of the "one another" statements instructs Christians to love one another. Another 15% stress an attitude of humility and respect among believers. And the rest of the statements are made up of various statements in Scripture that affirm over and over again that our actions and interaction with fellow believers are vitally important to the work of God in me and through me.

I pray that you will walk together with us each week as go on this journey through the "One Another" statements of Scripture.
