## CELEBRATING TEN YEARS OF SERVICE BY WADE ALLEN

The past year has brought about many opportunities to celebrate in our family—our son, Caleb, married the love of his life last November; Joanna and I celebrated thirty years of marriage in December; and our daughter, Carly, was recently blessed with a job serving the Lord in her specific area of giftedness. God has truly blessed us this past year!

However, the year has not been without its challenges. In November, Joanna broke her arm near the shoulder socket. By God's grace, she has been able to rehab her injury, but she is still not back to one-hundred-percent.

As Joanna was finishing up her time of rehab in March, I suffered a minor stroke in the occipital lobe of my brain. Six weeks later, I found myself in the emergency room with chest pains. Two days later, surgeons put in a stent to alleviate a ninety-five-percent blockage in my widow-maker artery. The fact that we are able to continue to serve here in this place—in spite of these difficulties—is truly a blessing from God!

It was 3,654 days ago when I stood

before you for the first time as your lead pastor. I am honored to serve the Lord in this role, and I am humbled when I think of how often I fail to shepherd you in the ways you need. I am so thankful that God has given me a team of men who partner with me as we attempt to serve the Lord by serving one another.

Thank you pastors (Ron, John and David) for coming alongside of me and filling in the gaps where my ministry prowess falters. You are an integral part of the ministry here at Temple!

As I look forward to the next decade and beyond, I see great things in store for our church! I want to thank you for allowing me to go on this journey with you. My prayer is that—above all else—God will be glorified in everything that is said and done in this place, that people will come to know the Lord as their Savior as a result of our ministry and outreach, and people will grow up in their faith to become mature men and women of God.
