QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

When you think about the future, do you believe you are ready for it?

In Luke 12:35-48, Jesus admonishes His followers to always be ready because “the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.” When He returns, it will be in order to bring judgment—blessings for the faithful and punishment for the unfaithful. How does knowing this affect the plans you have for the future? Or for today?

What do your present actions suggest you truly believe about the future? To what extent is Jesus’ imminent return affecting your actions and beliefs?

Do you struggle with a particular sin, or temptation, in your life? How would you feel if Jesus were to return at the same moment you were giving into that temptation?

How might quoting Luke 12:35 out loud help you to resist giving into that particular temptation?
